## End of Key Stage 2 Pupil Results 2018

**In 2018 the standards achieved at the end of KS2 are above National Averages:**

The percentage of pupil's achieving the expected standard is a combined measure across three subjects (Reading, Writing and Maths). To be counted towards the measure, a pupil must have a scaled **score of 100** or more in reading **and** a scaled score of 100 or more in maths **and** have been teacher assessed in writing as 'working at the expected standard' or 'working at a greater depth in the expected standard'.

The 'Sufficient Progress Measure' for 2018 has been set at -5 in Reading, -5 in Maths and -7 in English Writing.	
<b>Maths</b>	-0.73
<b>Reading</b>	0.49
<b>Writing</b>	0.02

### In 2018, a school will be above the floor if:

At least 65% of pupils meet the expected standard in English reading, English writing and mathematics; or

The school achieves sufficient progress scores in all three subjects:

At least -5 in English reading, -5 in mathematics and -7 in English Writing .

To be above the floor, the school needs to meet either the attainment or the entire progress element.

This means that Sacred Heart RCPS is Above Floor Standard for both measures.
